Bandroom Supervisor(s): Someone (or more) to supervise the bandroom, beginning around 30-45 minutes prior to 7pm and ending about 5 minutes before 7pm. This should be someone who is not a parent of a 6th grade band student, since the beginners will perform first. Also, we will need someone to supervise the return of the bandroom set-up as stands, chairs, and percussion instruments are returned to the bandroom after the concert.

Keeper of the Key: Typically, a few students will forget something (music, reed, etc.) and will need to get into the bandroom. I keep it locked during the concert. I won't be able to run back and forth to the bandroom to do this. However, if someone wants to get into the bandroom so they can pack up their instrument and leave before the end of concert, they'll just have to leave without their case. Hopefully, that won't be an issue, but more than likely, someone will want to leave after their child has performed and miss the other group. I discourage this, as it sends a bad message to the kids performing. By no means, should the Keeper of the Key miss any part of the performance to let someone into the bandroom.

Plants/Decor: It would be nice to have some greenery of some sort on both sides of the stage if possible. This is, usually, done easily by someone bringing his/her own artificial (or live) plant(s).

Line Leader: We need someone to lead the kids off the stage and into their assigned area in the auditorium when they are done with their part of the concert. Another line leader should lead the next group onto the stage as it empties. The kids leaving the stage will fill the space in the auditorium where the other group was sitting. The group leaving the stage exits on one side. The group entering the stage enters on the other side.

Auditorium Supervisor: Someone to go, "Shhhh!!!" if needed, especially with the band that is not on stage. They will be sitting together, in order, in the auditorium.
